We are committed to developing Christ-centered leaders through athletics while fostering faith, character, teamwork, sportsmanship, excellence, and responsible stewardship, ensuring every athlete has the opportunity to grow, compete, and honor Christ both on and off the field.





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Throughout the 2025–2026 school year, the Immanuel Crusader Athletic Boosters (ICAB) remained committed to strengthening and enhancing the athletic experience for every student-athlete served through the Multi-School Agreement. Through the dedication of our volunteers, the generosity of our sponsors and donors, and the unwavering support of our school community, ICAB invested in athletic programs, facilities, equipment, and opportunities that positively impacted student-athletes throughout the year. These accomplishments reflect our ongoing mission to provide resources that promote excellence, safety, stewardship, and Christ-centered leadership both on and off the field.

2025-2026 Highlights

- Supported 16 athletic programs across multiple sports and grade levels.
- Served more than 200 student-athletes throughout the school year.
- Conducted more than 20 fundraising events and campaigns to support athletic programs and facilities.
- Purchased thousands of dollars in new uniforms (football, flag football, Robotics, girls and boys' elementary basketball and additional uniforms for cheer and track) athletic equipment, and safety supplies.
- Paid \$13,845 in facility rental fees for rented locations and invested in football field enhancements.
- Conducted 4 sports banquets to acknowledge the student athletes, appreciate the parents and coaches and celebrate the team accomplishments.
- Hosted a small school Track Meet, welcoming approximately 200 athletes from across the region.
- Established new financial, fundraising, uniform, and equipment policies that strengthened accountability, transparency, and organizational stewardship.
- Launched new ICAB website.
- Created CA CDL guide to help volunteers understand the requirements for operating 12-passenger school vans.
- Expanded community engagement through new sponsorship opportunities, volunteer initiatives and participating in community events, including the car show and community Christmas parade.
- Participated in Immanuel Christian School events (Jubilee Banquet, Football Tail Gate party, Open House and Back to School Night).

These accomplishments are a testament to what can be achieved when families, coaches, volunteers, sponsors, and the community come together with a shared commitment to supporting our student-athletes. Every donation, volunteer hour, and partnership helps create opportunities for students to grow in faith, character, leadership, and athletic excellence.
